

Military Representatives to NATO MC at Baltic Barracks

On 28 June 2012, Danish, German and Polish Military Representatives to Military Committees (MC) of NATO and UE, and Estonian National Military Representative to Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe (SHAPE) paid a visit to Headquarters Multinational Corps Northeast (HQ MNC NE) in Szczecin.

In the era of transformation within the NATO Command Structure and the strive for new solutions allowing to confront maintaining sufficient capabilities with reduced organizational framework and financial outlays, representatives of the Corps' three Framework Nations – Denmark, Germany and Poland, and a representative of Estonia, one of the Corps' Participating States, met in Szczecin to discuss current developments, and future role and challenges of the Szczecin Corps.

'The heads of states of NATO nations decided in Lisbon two years ago to reduce the NATO Command Structure. That has a certain impact on the NATO Force Structure and the corps. One of those corps is the Szczecin Corps,' said Lieutenant General Hans-Lothar Domröse, the German Military Representative to NATO Military Committee.

'There is a need for support to the NATO Command Structure from the Force Structure Headquarters like this,'

said Lieutenant General Poul Kiærskou, the Danish Military Representative to NATO Military Committee and the head of the delegation.
