On 16 August 2012, the Commander of the Multinational Corps Northeast (MNC NE) Lieutenant General Rainer Korff and his wife, Sabine, handed over a voucher worth over 3 000 Polish złoty to representatives of Polish kids from the Children's Home No. 1 in Szczecin.

Having handed over the voucher, the visitors from the Corps had a chance to talk to children and taste some snacks together. An initial idea of using the voucher is to organize a common trip for children.
