

MNC NE on operation Determined Compatriot

In the early morning of 20 September 2012, soldiers from eight out of twelve countries of Multinational Corps Northeast, as Combined Joint Task Force (JTFC), joined in the Determined Compatriot operation under the command of Wislandia Joint Operational Command.

Szczecin-based Multinational Corps Northeast assumed the role of Combined Joint Task Force (CJTF) during Anakonda 12 exercise to perform High Intensity War-Fighting operations under the legal umbrella of Article 5, i.e. collective defence of NATO territory. An armed conflict which, in accordance with the Anakonda 12 scenario, had escalated in one of NATO countries, led to a military operation requiring close partnership of national and multinational troops, the latter being represented by CJTF.

„CJTF makes up the strategic reserve of Wislandia Joint Operational Command and currently holds the readiness to carry out counterattack in order to get back the positions taken by the Monda Troops and drive them off the Wislandia borders” – said Lieutenant Colonel Dariusz Dobroń, Chief Jointed Fires/Targeting working at the Current Operations Cross Functional Team.
