

VTC to summarize Anakonda 12

On behalf of Commander of Multinational Corps Northeast (MNC NE), Deputy Commander Major General Bogusław Samol took part in the Final Review of Anakonda 12 exercise held on 11 October 2012.

The meeting assumed a form of a videoconference allowing the units located in different parts of Poland to join in the session organised by the Polish Operational Command and to contribute to the process of analysis and assessment of the recently accomplished training event. MNC NE represented by Deputy Commander Major General Bogusław Samol participated in the meeting held at the 12 Mechanized Division Headquarters in Szczecin.

The overall concept of the videoconference was to evaluate the execution of tasks by the staffs and subordinate forces as well as the accomplishment of training objectives, and to bring up most important achievements, challenges and remarks.

General Samol presented the evaluation of Anakonda 12 from MNC NE perspective and pointed out the benefits of interaction with other units at different levels which positively influenced the Corps' ability to plan and conduct joint and combined operations.
