Maciej Gałązka serving in the MNC NE. Last year she was diagnosed with diabetes and since that time she had to have an injection of insulin five-times a day. The insulin pump would cost of approx. 14 000 PLN and it would let Magda to lead a normal life as all children at her age. The rest of the money will be donated by the entire HQ MNC NE.
