The Battle of Warsaw was fought from 13th to 25th August 1920, as Red Army forces, commanded by Mikhail Tukhachevski, approached the Polish capital of Warsaw and nearby Modlin Fortress. On August 16th, Polish forces commanded by Józef Piłsudski, counter-attacked from the south, forcing the Russian forces, into a disorganised withdrawal eastward and behind the Niemen River.

The event always ends with a barbecue attended by the families of all Headquarters' servicemen. For that reason the Polish Armed Forces' Day is a good occasion for all guests to be involved in the multinational environment, in that sense the HQ becomes not only the work place but also the ground where the true values such as tolerance, respect and cultural
