Worth seeing

"Multinational Corps Northeast – 10 years of success" will definitely serve its informational role. It presents all characteristic marks of the Corps including flags of all 11 countries contributing to the Corps as well as the NATO flag since the Headquarters has its permanent place within the NATO Force Structure.

As a matter of fact, everybody would find something interesting in the exhibition. Those who enjoy the art of photography can see a selection of best photos divided into four main categories, such as history, training and exercises, visits to the Headquarters and integration. Those who prefer exhibit items will have a chance to see a collection of various mementos and gadgets related to the Corps. A very unique showpiece is a flag of Headquarters Allied Land Forces Schleswig-Holstein and Jutland, a predecessor of Multinational Corps Northeast.

A real treat is definitely the section devoted to the mission in Afghanistan the Headquarters' soldiers participated in 2007. It includes photographs, mementos as well as battledress uniforms of all 11 Corps' nations. An unforgettable view will definitely be a splendid panorama of Kabul in Afghanistan.
