A group of about 100 officer cadets visited the Headquarters Multinational Corps Northeast (HQ MNC NE) on 9 April 2010 to learn more about the Corps.

The officer cadets coming from the German Army Officers School in Dresden took part in the briefing delivered by Lieutenant Colonel Lothar Hoffmann. The guests learned among other things about the Corps' history and tasks as well as the training and exercise cycle. Lieutenant Colonel Hoffmann also focused on the mission of the Corps' personnel in Afghanistan in 2007 and the ongoing deployment to the mission area.

After the briefing, the Commander of the Multinational Corps Northeast Lieutenant General Rainer Korff addressed all the students and their instructors.
