**The personnel of the Multinational Corps Northeast (MNC NE), both in Szczecin and Kabul, commemorated the tragic death of the Polish President Lech Kaczyński and other important personages who died in the plane crash on 10 April 2010. The ceremonies were held on 11 and 12 April.**

### **In Kabul**

On the initiative of Colonel Dawidczyk, the Polish Senior National Officer for Polish MNC NE personnel serving in Kabul, the line-up was held on 11 April 2010 at noon Polish time, 14:30 Kabul time. The Polish servicemen from the Corps, other Polish personnel serving at the ISAF Joint Command (IJC) as well as representatives of other nations who joined in the ceremony, gathered in front of the Polish flag, which was lowered to half-mast. Just like in Poland, everybody commemorated the tragically dead Poles with two minutes of silence.

All Polish personnel also signed a letter of condolence, which was taken to the Polish Embassy in Kabul.
