



On 22 July 2010, a group of students from the North-Caucasian Academy of Public Administration in Rostov, Russia, and the Higher School of Public Administration in Szczecin, Poland, visited the Headquarters Multinational Corps Northeast (HQ MNC NE).

The visit was about learning what the Multinational Corps Northeast is. Lieutenant Colonel Grzegorz Kołodziej, Chief Public Affairs, kindly welcomed the visitors and delivered a briefing about tasks and missions as well as structure and history of the Corps, which is a part of the NATO Force Structure.
