From 18 to 30 October 2010, two staff officers, LTC Waldemar Torbicki and Mr Marian Cihon from Headquarters Multinational Corps Northeast (HQ MNC NE) supported 1 (German/Netherlands) Corps during the Command Post Exercise (CPX) Nemesis Sword 2010.

The Command Post Exercise Nemesis Sword 2010 provided an opportunity to train HQ (DEU) Air Mobile Division (AMD), HQ (FRA) État-Major de Force N° 1 and their subordinate units within complex Peace Support Operation scenario. In total, 2,500 participants from 14 nations sharpened their skills and expertise working in multinational military and civilian training community portraying brigades, other units and civilian organisations. Members of Multinational Corps Northeast supported the exercise in the field of Civil Military Cooperation (CIMIC) and Public Affairs (PA). Exercise was executed in German training area MTA Bergen near Münster.
