


The Corps' new structure in spring!

On 16 May 2011, Headquarters Multinational Corps Northeast (HQ MNC NE) reorganised its peacetime structure and employed a new G7 Staff Division, thus making the Headquarters' structure more similar to structures of other corps within the NATO family.

Up to now, the Headquarters consisted of the Command Group and seven Staff Divisions: from G1 to G6 and G8. However, within the G3 Division responsible for operations, mission preparation process as well as training and exercises, an independent G7 Division has been sectioned off and manned by the available personnel of the Training & Exercise Branch of G3 Division.

Temporarily headed by a German Lieutenant Colonel, the new G7 Division has taken over all tasks related to planning, conducting training and exercises of Headquarters and synchronizing them with other undertakings of the Corps and organisations cooperating with the Corps.

The anew defined role of G3 Division focuses on operations, in particular concepts of planning, preparations, conduct and control of all Corps' missions.
