

DCOM at 92nd anniversary of creation of National Police

On 20 July 2011, Deputy Commander of the Multinational Corps Northeast (MNC NE) Major General Ryszard Sorokosz participated in the annual celebrations of 92nd anniversary of forming the Polish National Police.
