

Concert Grand: checking off before Little Eagle II

On the invitation of the Commander of Command Support Brigade (CSB) Colonel Wojciech Kucharski , the Commander of Multinational Corps Northeast (MNC NE) Lieutenant General Rainer Korff visited the Concert Grand II/11 exercise organised by CSB prior to the upcoming Corps' exercise, Little Eagle II.

First, the main idea of the Concert Grand II/11 exercise and specific tasks performed by CSB battalions were presented by the CSB Deputy Commander/Chief of Staff Colonel Marian Matoszka and Commanders of CSB battalions. Afterwards, the MNC NE Commander and other members of the Headquarters and Air Operations Coordination Centre visited command posts of CSB checking on the equipment used and communication possibilities available. General Korff got especially interested in the Polish mobile ground terminal "Fikus", radio station "Harris" and Integrated Command and Control Vehicle 3 (ZWD 3). The MNC NE Commander tested radio communication with operators stationed in Prenzlau. The next part of the visit covered various aspects of technical support including servers and information systems. Finally, the visitors moved to a trunk node located next to Barnisław where they were presented with communication tools used there and got acquainted with working and living field conditions over there.
