



On 25 November 2011, a conference on Geoinformation Systems (GIS) was held in Warsaw.

The conference was hosted by the National Defence Academy headed by Colonel Dariusz Kozerawski. During the time issues related to the use of GIS in military and public safety were presented. Among the invited about 150 guests for the conference were mainly representatives from the General Staff of the Polish Armed Forces, military intelligence units, Police, Fire Departments and institutions responsible for crisis management.

Headquarters Multinational Corps Northeast (HQ MNC NE) was represented by Lieutenant Colonel Carsten Scholz and Sergeant Major Andreas Neuhaus. They briefed about "Use of ArcGIS in HQ MNC NE, Exercises and Missions".
