

Opening of the Training and Doctrine Centre

The Commander of the Multinational Corps Northeast (MNC NE) Lieutenant General Rainer Korff participated in the opening ceremony of the Training and Doctrine Centre of the Polish Armed Forces (TRADOC) held in Bydgoszcz on 9 December 2011.

The highest Polish military representatives, including Deputy Chief of the Polish General Staff Lieutenant General Mieczysław Gocuł, representatives of regional and local authorities as well as partners – like Multinational Corps Northeast represented by its Commander Lieutenant General Rainer Korff – were present at the opening ceremony in Bydgoszcz which completes a formation process of a new unit, the Training and Doctrine Centre of the Polish Armed Forces. The Centre named after General Władysław Sikorski will focus on three major areas, namely the standardization process the aim of which is to adjust the procedures of the Polish Armed Forces to NATO standards considering the Polish regulations and national interests; implementation of mission experiences gathered by the Polish Armed Forces; and experiments on new concepts and doctrine.

The Centre will also cooperate with Multinational Corps Northeast. As a matter of fact, Brigadier General Franciszek Kochanowski, the Director of the Centre, participated in the tripartite meeting held at Baltic Barracks in Szczecin last week together with representatives of the Multinational Corps Northeast and 2nd Mechanized Corps to specify the areas of tripartite cooperation. Considering the intensified partnership between the two Corps – a national and a
