



From 22 until 31 October 2012 the Mobile Education and Training Team from the NATO School in Oberammergau, Germany, conducted the NATO/ISAF Intelligence Course, at the Baltic Barracks in Szczecin.

The personnel from the Headquarters Multinational Corps Northeast will deploy to Afghanistan in 2014, but the training and preparation for the mission has already started in some areas. For the purpose of common education and maintaining the very good cooperation representatives from the 2nd Polish Mechanized Corps, 9th Reconnaissance Regiment, the 8th Baltic Defence Flotilla, the Central Psychological Operations Group, and the German 610 Signal Battalion as well as personnel from the Headquarters itself took part in the course executed by an invited team of subject matter experts. The aim of the course was to provide the basic NATO/ISAF intelligence and analyst skills. The programme included both the theoretical parts and the exercises conducted in smaller groups.
