On request of Mr. Artur Szalabawka, the Chief of the Westpomeranian Headquarters of Voluntary Labour Corps, Major Marcin Czekalski paid a visit to the Sports School Complex, managed by Mr. Jarosław Duda, to provide a briefing about Multinational Corps Northeast.

"The Corps itself is very interesting, especially the exercises like Crystal Eagle or Anakonda 12, in which the multinational Headquarters took part," said Ms. Sylwia Piotrowicz, the Chief of the 16-10 Labour Squad of the Voluntary Labour Corps.

"For the first time our students had an opportunity to familiarize with the Corps' history, tasks, role and daily life in Baltic Barracks," she added.

The briefing additionally described how the cooperation between the three Framework Nations of the Corps, i.e. Denmark, Germany and Poland, and the other nine Participating States works. The students were mostly interested in what the Corps really is, what it does and what conditions one has to meet in order to join the Corps.
