



The Deputy Commander acts on the Commander's behalf when required and performs other duties as directed by the Commander. Furthermore, the Deputy Commander advises the Commander in all fields of concern related to the Corps.

Brigadier General Morten Danielsson was born in 1960. During his professional career he served, among other positions, as Second in Command and Commander of the Battery at the Kings Artillery Regiment. He held several positions at the Defence Command Denmark, including Chief of the Defence Organisation and Structure Branch and Chief of the Executive Office. He assumed the position of the Deputy Commander of Multinational Corps Northeast on 14 January 2013 directly after having been released from duty as the Corps' Chief of Staff which he had performed since 26 May 2010. In fact, it is already General Danielsson's third assignment the Corps. From 2001 to 2004 he also served in Szczecin as Chief Military Assistant.
